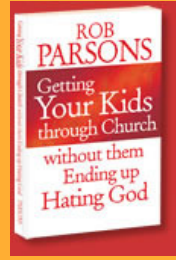
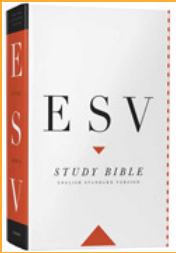


Praying for the world
