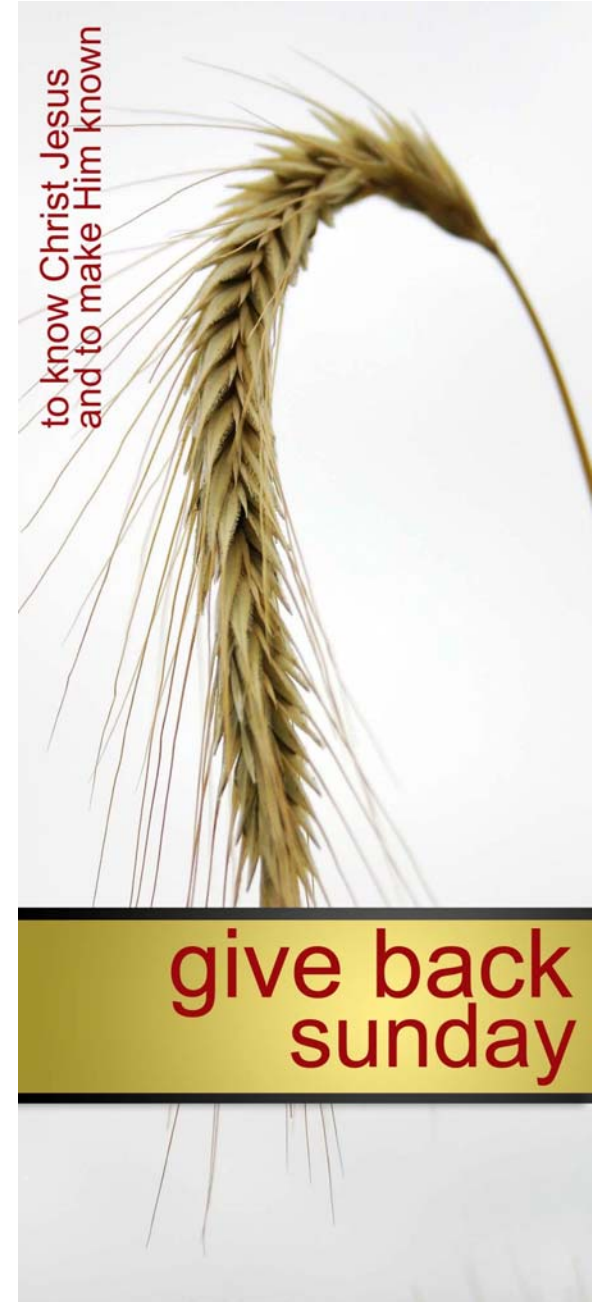

• **Our generous heart is Blessed by the Lord**

The miracle of stewardship is that the more we give, the more we receive, not in kind, but God’s gift to us is greater than our gifts to Him. (2 Corinthians 9:8)
